

## Equine Baselines

- Temperature: 99.5° – 101.5° F
- Pulse: 30 – 40 beats/minute
- Respiration: 8 – 16 breaths/minute
- Gum Tissue Color: Pink & moist
- Capillary Refill Time: Within 2 seconds (*time it takes for color to return to gum tissue*)
- GI Mobility: 3 – 4 gut sounds/minute
- Water Consumption: 8 – 20 gallons/day
- Defecate: Every 3 – 4 hours

*Equine baselines are based on 1000# horse.*

## Fly & Insect Repellant

- 10 Drops Idaho Tansy\*
- 10 Drops Purification
- 8 oz Water

Mix together in a spray bottle and shake before use.

**Warnings:** Keep out of eyes. \*Do not use Idaho Tansy on horse or rider if pregnant, nursing or epileptic.
